**F – Sunday School Teacher Letter of Recommendation (instructions):**

Separate from this application form, please ask a Sunday School Teacher for a Letter of Recommendation. To select a teacher for a recommendation, consider 1) in what grade and class the teacher knows you, 2) how aware the teacher is of your active participation and 3) how enthusiastic you were as a student. The recommendations will be submitted using the ICB Sunday School Teacher Recommendation Form available as PDF at Scholarship home page. Kindly download and email it the teacher or request her/him to download.

**G – Terms and Signature:**
