**E – Essay (instructions):**

Separate from this application form, please prepare a **two-page** essay (**double-spaced with 12 point Ariel font**) that demonstrates a deep understanding of a concept in Islam or Arabic. Examples could include: contributions to Islam in science, things that tie Islam to their everyday life, a fiqh-based analysis of various treatments of music in Islam, an aspect of women in Islam, an analysis of linguistic patterns in early Arabic grammar and their implications, etc. We want you to include your thoughts and reflections on the topic and “why does it matter to you?”. Submit this write-up in pdf with the application form.

**F – Sunday School Teacher Letter of Recommendation (instructions):**

Separate from this application form, please ask a Sunday School Teacher for a Letter of Recommendation. This should be evaluated based on 1) in what grade and class the teacher knows you, 2) how aware the teacher is of your active participation and 3) how enthusiastic you were as a student. The letter should be 1 page double-spaced and signed by the teacher with the teacher’s name below the signature line. Ensure you follow-up with the teacher to ensure this has been completed and mailed.

**G – Terms and Signature:**

If awarded a scholarship, I agree to take at least 2 courses in Islam or Arabic during the 4 years of college (either at the college attended or related program). In addition, I will return to the Sunday School at least once during my Junior or Senior year to share what I have learned and my experiences with the then current 10<sup>th</sup> grade class.
