Key Elements of the Scholarship

- Scholarship
 - Based on **academic achievement**
 - Promotes ICB **community service**
 - Focuses on a **commitment** to ICB Wayland and Islam
 - Emphasizes Privacy & Impartiality
- Why this session?
 - Awareness for HS seniors (and younger students) of merit scholarship
 - Build a culture of community service (11th & 12th graders + more)

Merit Scholarship Eligibility

- Completed at least 6 years of ICB Wayland Sunday School and has graduated 10th grade
- Completed community service or participated in ICB Wayland activities at the Center
- Accepted to an accredited 4-year college and plan to attend
- Plans to take at least 2 courses or involvement in Islam/ Arabic during the 4 years of college
- Parents are members (or student is a members) of the ICB Wayland community
- US Citizenship or permanent residency



Merit Scholarship Materials Submission

- **ICB college scholarship Application Form** (on website at <http://www.icbwayland.org/collegescholarship/index.html>)
- **600-word essay** demonstrating understanding of a significant concept (student's choosing) in Islam or Arabic
- **600-word essay of their community service** at the Islamic Center of Boston and his/her interest in continuing to study Islam or Arabic
- One **letter of recommendation** from an ICB Sunday School teacher (on-line rubric)
- Student's **High School transcript** (with high school seal)

C – ICB Community Service Activities & Responsibilities Table

Describe activities and responsibilities you have performed or participated in during grades 9-12 (relating to religion or Arabic language) that demonstrate a desire to improve yourself and your community. Emphasis is giving to ICB Wayland sponsored or related activities. Some of these activities can be further expanded on in your community service write-up in section D.

Examples of activities may include volunteering for a clean-up project at ICB Sunday School, being a teacher's assistant for a class at ICB Sunday School, participating in the ICB Youth Group, organizing independent programs relevant to ICB's mission, participating in charity events (e.g., FPM, MCSS, etc.) consistent with the principles of our Sunday School teachings, etc. Also add the approximate number of hours you participated in an activity. D – ICB Community Service/Interest Write-up (instructions):

Separate from the application form, prepare a **600-word** write-up that describes (a) details of one or two of your activities that contribute directly to the betterment of the ICB-Wayland community and (b) your interest in continuing to study some aspect of Islam or Arabic during your college years. Submit this write-up in pdf with the application form.

E – Essay (instructions):

Separate from this application form, please prepare a **600-word** essay that demonstrates a deep understanding of a concept in Islam or Arabic. Examples could include: contributions to Islam in science, things that tie Islam to your everyday life, a fiqh-based analysis of various treatments of music in Islam, an aspect of women in Islam, an analysis of linguistic patterns in early Arabic grammar and their implications, etc. We want you to include your thoughts and reflections on the topic and “why does it matter to you?” Submit this write-up in pdf with the application form.

F – Sunday School Teacher Letter of Recommendation (instructions):

Separate from this application form, please ask a Sunday School Teacher for a Letter of Recommendation. To select a teacher for a recommendation, consider 1) in what grade and class the teacher knows you, 2) how aware the teacher is of your active participation and 3) how enthusiastic you were as a student. The letter should be 1 page double-spaced and signed by the teacher with the teacher’s name below the signature line. Ensure you follow-up with the teacher to ensure this has been completed and mailed.



Impartial


- Candidates treated equally. No preference.
